<b>4.2.</b>	<b>Heats</b>	There will be <b>2 Heats</b> . The Grid positions for <b>Heat 1</b> will be set from times achieved in Qualifying, with fastest time on grid 1 and so on.
		The Grid positions for <b>Heat 2</b> will be set times achieved in Qualifying in reverse order, with the slowest on Pole Position etc.
<b>4.3.</b>	<b>Pre-Finals</b>	There will be <b>2 Pre-Finals</b> . <b>Pre-Final 1.</b> The grid for the Pre-final 1 will be set from accumulated points of Heat 1 and Heat 2 with the highest points starting on Pole Position
		<b>Pre- Final 2.</b> The grid for Pre-final 2 will be set from accumulated points of Heat 1, Heat 2 and Pre-final 1 with lowest points starting on Pole position
<b>4.4.</b>	<b>Final</b>	<b>1 Final</b> The grid for the final will be set from accumulated points of the 2 Heats and 2 Pre-finals with highest points on Pole position

<b>3.1.</b>	Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.
<b>3.2.</b>	Retrieval of karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course or stewards of the meeting
<b>3.3.</b>	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a <b>HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST</b> on the upper torso.
<b>3.4.</b>	Karts can be retrieved via the grids at the discretion of the officials.
<b>4.</b>	<b>ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS</b>
<b>4.1.</b>	No animals allowed anywhere within the facility.
<b>4.2.</b>	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements.
<b>4.3.</b>	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the circuit.
<b>4.4.</b>	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
