4.3.		The Grid for Heat 2 will replicate the finishing order of Heat 1. For K22 only, The Grid for Heat 2 will be set from times achieved in Qualifying, with fastest time on grid 1, and so on.
4.4.	Pre-final	1 Pre-final. The grid for the Pre-final will be set using the Zero Points system with the lowest points from the 2 heats going to grid 1 and so on.
4.5.	Final	1 Final. The grid for the Final will be set using the Zero Points system with the lowest points
