5.2.	Shootout	Top x 5 time from qualifying sessions will complete a shoot out – 1 timed lap.
5.3.	Classes Split	Based on Qualifying times, classes will be split into A & B classes as determined by the Officials
5.4.	Heats	There will be 1 Heat. The Grid for Heat 1 set from times achieved in Shoot out and Qualifying, with the fastest time on grid 1, and so on.

5.5.	Pre-finals	<p>There will be 2 Pre-finals.</p> <p>1 Pre-final The grid for Pre-final 1 will replicate the finishing order of Heat 1.</p> <p>2 Pre-final. The grid for Pre-final 2 will be set from the points tally from Heat and Pre-Final 1 with the highest points to grid 1, second highest to grid 2 and so on.</p>
