2.	289 points system for all classes except KZ2. Zero points system for KZ2	
3.	Practice	Practice sessions of 3 hours on Friday afternoon and 2 hours on Saturday morning. NOTE: COMPATIBLE CLASSES WILL BE COMBINED FOR PRACTICE AND CARBY TUNE
4.	There Will be timed qualifying at this event.	
5.	FORMAT 1 – TIMED QUALIFYING EVENT	
	If Timed Qualifying will occur (Kart order must be random – no high/low numbers):	
5.1.	Qualifying	One Qualifying Session of 6 minutes
5.2.	Heats	There will be 2 Heats . The Grid for Heat 1 will be set from times achieved in Qualifying, with the fastest time on grid 1, and so on. The Grid for Heat 2 will replicate the finishing order of Heat 1. (KZ2 Heat 2 grid will be set from times achieved in qualifying, with fastest time on grid 1)
5.3.	Pre-final	1 Pre-final The grid for the Pre-final (all classes except KZ2) will be set from the points tally with the highest points to grid 1 and so on. Lowest points will go to grid 1 for KZ2.
5.4.	Final	1 Final The grid for the Final (all classes except KZ2) will be set from the points tally with the highest points to grid 1 and so on. For the KZ2 the grid for the Final will replicate the finishing order of the Pre-Final. In KZ2 only , the winner of the Final is the winner of the day. In all other classes , the driver with the highest points tally is the winner of the day.
