The grid for Heat 1 will be set from times achieved in Qualifying, with fastest time on grid 1 and so on. The Grid for Heat 2 will be set in accordance with the results of Heat 1 with the winner on Pole position and so on.		
5.	Pre-Final	Highest accumulated points from Heat 1 and Heat 2 will start on Pole Position and so on.		
6.	Final	Highest accumulated points from Heat 1, Heat 2 and Pre Final will start on Pole Position and so on.		
7.	Points	289 points system to be used. All points count. Winner is the driver with the highest points at completion of racing.

3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso.
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via the in or out grids at the Grid Marshalls' direction.

4.1.	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.
