3.	KART RETRIEVAL
3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.
3.2.	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso.
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via In Grid or Out Grid once ALL KARTS HAVE CONCLUDED THAT RACE
4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
4.1.	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements.
4.3.	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
4.4.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, drones, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials or committee members may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
4.5.	Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club.
4.6.	NO REMOTE CONTROL CARS OF ANY KIND ARE TO BE USED AT ALL FOR THE DURATION OF THE MEETING
4.7.	Food Trucks will be organised by the Club for this race meeting. Canteen will not be available.
4.8.	Engines and Restrictors may be sealed for this Meeting.
4.9.	Bar coding may occur at this Meeting.
4.10.	Clear visors may be necessary to be used under the advice from Officials.
4.11.	Overflow parking will be available in Coastal MX Club compound. Please do not park vehicles on Cockburn Road, and DO NOT block driveways outside our gates, Vehicles may be towed if parked illegally. Please ensure your children stay off the motorcross track.
5.	STATE REGULATIONS REMINDERS
5.1	<p>Competition Numbers</p> <p>a) At any State, Zonal or Club Competition, a visiting Driver will have preference in the allocation of a Competition number except in the circumstance where the competition number is the Drivers KA Competition Licence Number.</p> <p>b) Should there be a duplication in Competition numbers in accordance with Competition Rules, Chapter 1 Rule 11 j) and Regulation 7a) above, the final decision on the allocation of Competition numbers is to be made by the Organising Club.</p>

<p>5.2</p>	<p>Video Recording System</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i) It is mandatory for each Kart competing in each State Series, State Cup, State Trophy and Zonal Series to have a video recording system that is mounted in accordance with Technical Rules, Chapter 1, Rule 8 i) (iv) and be fully operational at all times while the Kart is on the Track. ii) The date and time on the camera must be set to the time zone of the Meeting. <p>Video Recording System- Recording Medium (SD Card) Procedures</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i) A separate SD card must be used for each Class or Division contested at a Meeting. ii) Prior to the commencement of on-track activity on each day of Competition, the Recording Medium used in the camera fitted to a Kart must be completely cleared and reformatted. iii) No recorded vision on the Recording Medium may be deleted from the time that on-track activity has commenced on each day of a Meeting until one (1) hour after the completion of the following Event, without the prior written permission of the Stewards.
