**5 Heats, 289 points system, Classes / Weights buddied up,
Set race order. Random Ballot format is back in 2019.**

CLASSES TO RACE AND COMBINATIONS OF WEIGHTS:

NOTE: As listed, these classes / weights will race on the track at the same time.

- a) Cadet 9 (Mini Rok Restricted 99kg)
b) Cadet 9 (Comer 90kg, Yamaha J 100kg)
c) Cadet 4SS (100kg - Briggs & Stratton 206 and Torini Clubmaxx 210)
- a) Cadet 12 (Mini Rok 108kg, Yamaha J 105kg)
- a) KA4 Junior Light (KA100 restricted 128kg)
b) KA4 Junior Heavy (KA100 restricted 148kg)
c) Yamaha Junior (KT100J 131kg – all KT100S engines must be fitted with a fin dampening system 141kg)
d) Junior 4SS (130kg - Briggs & Stratton 206 and Torini Clubmaxx 210)
- a) KA2 (Vortex Rok DVS (Junior) 142kg)
b) KA3 Junior (KA100 144kg)
- a) KA3 Senior Light (KA100 149kg)
b) KA3 Senior Medium (KA100 169kg)
c) KA3 Masters (KA100 169kg)
d) KA3 Senior Heavy (KA100 189kg)
- a) WA Open Performance (as per State Regulations)
b) TAG 125 Light (Rotax Max EVO & Non EVO 162kg, IAME X30 160kg, Galaxy 156kg, Fireball/Leopard/Cheetah 155kg)
c) TAG 125 Heavy (Rotax Max EVO & Non EVO 182kg, IAME X30 180kg, Galaxy 176kg, Fireball/Leopard/Cheetah 175kg)
- a) TAG 125 Restricted Light (Rotax EVO 167kg, All other approved engines 162kg)
b) TAG 125 Restricted Masters (Rotax EVO 180kg, All other approved engines 175kg)
c) TAG 125 Restricted Medium (Rotax EVO 187kg, All other approved engines 182kg)
- a) Yamaha Senior Medium (161kg - all KT100S engines must be fitted with a fin dampening system)
b) Senior Light 4SS (140kg - Briggs & Stratton 206 and Torini Clubmaxx 210)
c) Senior Medium 4SS (155kg - Briggs & Stratton 206 and Torini Clubmaxx 210)

RACE FORMAT : Five (5) Heats – Format 15

- Heat 1 - Random Ballot
Heat 2 - Random Ballot (reverse of Heat 1)
Heat 3 - Highest points to front
Heat 4 - Highest points to front
Final - Highest Points to front.
- 289 point system. All points count - Winner is highest point scorer on day!
- Points are accumulated throughout the year, in order to determine Club Champion for each class/weight division at end of 2019.
- Non Tiger Kart Club Members will race where they are, but have all points removed after completion of the Final.

RACE ORDER: The Race Order is set for the year. Due to the timing system, we do not rotate every month. NB: This Race Order may change on the day, if no entries are received in any of the class groups – this will be announced at Drivers Brief.

- **P Platers MUST have their kart scrutineered by an Official before lodging their entry. All Drivers must lodge their entry before Registration closes. You will not be permitted to commence racing unless you have lodged your entry.**
- **Transponders** are compulsory at all race events for all drivers.
- Don't forget a clear visor is required for day/night meetings.
- **Please make sure your scrutineering form is filled out correctly with ALL information clear, such as your name, the class you are racing and transponder number. Incorrect or incomplete information on scrutineering forms is the major cause of delays during registration. GET IT RIGHT AND WE START RACING ON TIME.**
