POLICY FOR CLUB DUTIES

DEFINITIONS:

Busy Bee: cleaning/maintenance day activities held as and when arranged by the Club throughout the year in which attendance of a total of 8 hrs is required in lieu of completing **Club Duties** on a **Club Day** or **Open Race**

Club: means the Tiger Kart Club Inc., Perth, Western Australia

Club Championship: the annual racing competition conducted by the Club between January and December each calendar year of Club Days, split by the nominated classes. Points for this competition are only awarded to current financial members of the **Club**. A maximum of ten (10) **Club Days** will be eligible for the **Club Championship** during the year, as determined by the **Committee**.

Club Day: single day **Club** run race events (this excludes Club fun days and "Have a go" days) – whole of one day's racing

Club Duties: means the attendance by a member, or in the case of a Cadet or Junior member, a parent or guardian, at a **Club Day** or **Open Race** or **Busy Bee** conducted by the **Club**, at either the Cockburn or Wanneroo tracks, to perform duties, as allocated by the **Club**, during a race meeting, and such duties are completed to the satisfaction of the **Club**.

Club Duties Points: 3,000 points awarded for successful completion of **Club Duties**

Committee: the elected committee of the **Club**

Member: a current financial member of the **Club**

Open Race: Open race authorised by Karting WA held by the **Club** (including State or National Title events) – whole of one day's racing

POLICY:

The underlying premise of **Club Duties** is as follows:

Race meetings can only be conducted if sufficient **Club** members attend and complete their **Club Duties**. If insufficient members (a minimum of 8, and maximum of 15 are required) attend to complete their **Club Duties** at a race meeting, the meeting may be cancelled by the **Committee**.

1. Members who have requested to complete **Club Duties** at any race meeting will only receive **Club Duties Points** if that meeting goes ahead and the member carries out the nominated Club Duties for the complete race day.
2. A maximum of ten (10) Club Day meetings conducted by the **Club** between 1st January and 31st December, will be eligible for the **Club Championship**, as determined by the **Committee**.
3. In the event that a **Club Day** race event is not held, a 'Fun Day' meeting may be held instead and will be staffed by the **Committee**, but if there is a requirement to supplement **Club Duties** positions by **Members**, then this race meeting may become available, at the discretion of the **Committee**, for some **members** to complete their **Club Duties**.
4. One (1) less than the total number of eligible **Club Day** race meetings run during the **Club Championship**, will count towards overall **Club Championship** points.

For example, if ten (10) **Club Days** are available and run, only nine (9) of those will count toward the **Club Championship**. One (1) of these nine (9) **Club Days** must be **Club Duties** and the points from the remaining eight (8) **Club Days** will count towards the **Club Championship**. If only nine (9) **Club Days** are available and run, only eight (8) of those will count toward the **Club Championship**, and one of the eight (8) **Club Days** must be **Club Duties**, with the remaining seven (7) **Club Day** points counting towards the **Club Championship**. And so on.

In the case where a **Member** has raced at all available **Club Days** for the year **and** completed their **Club Duties** at a **Busy Bee** or **Open Race**, as opposed to a **Club Day**, the two (2) lowest point **Club Days** they participated in must be excluded for the calculation of **Club Championship**. For example, if ten (10) Club Days are available and run, only eight (8) Club Days will count towards the Club Championship.

In each instance a Club Day is excluded for the calculation of the points for the **Club Championship**, it will be the **Club Day** with the lowest points excluded first, then second lowest and so on.

5. Parents or guardians, including the driving members of Cadet and Junior drivers, will be required to perform **Club Duties** on behalf of their children for **Club Duties Points** to be allocated. Parents or guardians only need to complete one (1) set of **Club Duties** for all children they have racing. If the parent or guardian is a driving **Member**, they may also complete their own **Club Duties** at the same time.
6. Any **Member** or, in the case of a Cadet or Junior **Member**, a parent or guardian, not having completed

Club Duties before 30th November of the calendar year will not be eligible for the **Club Championship**.

7. The **Club** reserves the right to refuse race entries for future race meetings at the **Club**, for any **Members** who have not undertaken their **Club Duties**, irrespective of them having joined another club and ceased membership with the Club. (As voted by club members attending the 2015 Annual General Meeting)
8. A **Member** must complete a minimum of 50% (rounded up) of the **Club Days**, as well as complete their **Club Duties**, to be eligible for the **Club Championship**. A **Member** may commence or cease racing in any particular **Club Day** race class at any time during the **Club Championship** year.

This Policy document is provided for **Member's** general information as to how the **Club** endeavours to ensure that planned race days, and in particular **Club Days**, can proceed with YOUR help.

Members of the **Committee** may consider alternative arrangements for a **Member** in exceptional circumstances and only upon written application by the **Member**.
