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CLUB DUTIES POLICY (2026)

1. Awards & Prizes

- Club Championship Awards:
 - 1st Place: Trophy + Gold Club Membership
 - 2nd Place: Trophy + Silver Club Membership
 - 3rd Place: Trophy + Standard Club Membership
- Special Trophies:
 - Junior & Senior Club Member of the Year (Perpetual Trophies)
 - Most Improved Cadet
 - Most Improved Junior
 - Karting Activity Controller (KAC) of the Year
- Race Day Prizes:
 - Cadet 9/12 podium: Individual trophy at each event
 - Junior/Senior podium: Annual trophy for first podium of the year, with a plaque for other podiums throughout the year
 - 3 x \$50 cash prizes (random draw for cadets, juniors, seniors—must be present to win)
 - 1 x \$100 cash prize (random draw and must be present to claim, rolls over to following month if not claimed, redrawn at year-end ceremony if November draw is unclaimed until it is claimed)
- Prize Adjustments:
 - The committee may adjust prizes based on entry numbers.

2. Membership Types & Benefits

- Gold Membership (\$885/year incl GST):
 - Standard membership
 - Free race day entries
 - Unlimited practice
 - Club T-shirt
 - 20% discount at Tiger Canteen/Bar
- Silver Membership (\$600/year incl GST):
 - Standard membership
 - Up to 8 free race day entries
 - Practice fees: \$25/session

Further discounts apply for family groups – see club website for details

3. Club Duties – What You Need to Know

- Definition:
 - Club Duties = volunteering at race events or Busy Bee (maintenance) days, as assigned by the Club.
- Requirement:
 - 8 hours of Club Duties per class entered (e.g., 2 classes = 16 hours).
 - Duties must be completed by the member, or for Cadet/Junior drivers, by a parent/guardian or approved delegate for all above.
- Eligibility:
 - Must complete Club Duties for each class to be eligible for Club Championship awards.
 - Duties must be finished before November 30th.
 - It's recommended to finish duties before the last event of the year.
- Consequences:
 - Not completing duties = not eligible for awards/prizes.
 - The Club may refuse future race entries for members who don't complete duties.

4. Race Events & Points

- Club Championship:
 - Runs January–November, up to 11 events will be held.
 - Must be a member on race day to earn points.
 - Points based on finishing position (289-point system) with no points adjustment after removal of non-members
 - Only your best 8 event results per class count for the championship.
 - If fewer than 8 events are held, all results count.
 - Points and duties are tracked separately for each class—no transfers.
- Minimum Participation:
 - Must compete in at least 50% of events held (rounded up) for each class to be eligible for awards.

5. Special Circumstances

- Members can apply in writing to the Committee for alternative arrangements if exceptional circumstances prevent them from completing Club Duties.
